

16 POINTS OF THE COMPASS

JUNIOR EVENT

Equipment: 16 Compass Direction Cards (cards to be 12" square white poster board, each with one of the sixteen points of the compass written in large block letters).

Team: Minimum of two unit members.

Procedure: Team members are to line up in relay formation 10 feet from a twelve-foot diameter circle marked on the ground. At the starting signal, team member #1 runs to pile of face-down Direction Cards and places the top card, face-up at any of the sixteen marks which are spaced equally around the circle. No. 1 then returns to tag #2, who takes second card and places it in correct relationship to the first card. Action continues, relay style, until all cards have been placed.

No card may be relocated after the team member who placed it has tagged the following member. A correct card should be placed over an incorrect card to minimize loss of score.

Scoring: Scoring will be based on the number of correctly placed cards and on elapsed time. Timing will stop when the last team member crosses the start-finish line after placement of the sixteenth card.

Note: Judge will place one of the four cardinal points (N-E-S-W) as the top card. The cards will be shuffled and placed face-down in the center of the 12-foot circle before each contest.
