

BOW SAW RELAY

JUNIOR & TEEN EVENT (separate not combined)

Equipment: (to be furnished by conference)

Logs of uniform size - 6" to 8" diameter
Log or block for support of log being sawn

(to be furnished by club)

Bow Saw - one man size

Team: Minimum 2 - Maximum 8 unit members

Procedure: Each team is to line up in relay formation at a line twenty feet from the log and the saw. At the starting signal, the first two team members run to the log. One team member steadies the log while the other team member saws off a disk approximately 2" thick. As soon as the disk hits the ground, the team members switch positions and saw off another disk. When the second disk drops off, both team members run back to the start-finish line and tag the next two team members, who repeat the actions of the first two team members. Action continues until each team member has sawn off one disk each.

Scoring: The score will be the average elapsed time from the starting signal till the final two team members cross the finish line after the last disk is sawn off.

Note: Both team members sawing the log are to return across the start-finish line between each pair of disks sawn regardless of the number of members on the team.
