

LOG HAULING

TEEN EVENT

Equipment: (to be furnished by Conference)

1 log - 7 feet long x 6" in diameter at smaller end
1 rope - 1/2" diameter x 60 feet long

Team: Minimum of 2 - maximum of 4

Procedure: Unit lines up at start-finish line 60 feet from log and coiled rope. At starting signal, entire unit runs to log and coiled rope. One unit member ties a TIMBER HITCH (see N.A.D. Adventist Youth Classes INSTRUCTOR'S GUIDE, page 898) around log. Each unit member then makes a MAN-HARNESS KNOT (see N.A.D. Adventist Youth Classes INSTRUCTOR'S GUIDE, page 902) on the rope and places it around one shoulder. When all unit members are ready, the unit drags the log across the start-finish line.
(The MAN-HARNESS KNOT should be tied large enough to go around a person's shoulder, leaving both hands free).

Scoring: Score will be the total elapsed time from the starting signal till the log is completely across the start-finish line. All knots must be tied correctly or unit will be disqualified.
